There has also been substance abuse in the form of marijuana in his family (his father). came up as Low probability for having a Substance Dependency Disorder on the SASSI test.

The recommendation is GOP, (General Outpatient Treatment) at a Substance abuse treatment Center. This is recommended so that he can get some education, relapse prevention, and learn how to deal with hard things in a healthier way.
